Operator Safety

Operators must be well-versed in the controls and functions of the Denago® EV product. Always utilize seat belts and confirm that the vehicle is functioning properly before commencing your drive. To ensure safety, avoid distractions while driving, and keep hands and feet inside the vehicle at all times.

Maintain a safe and controlled speed, particularly in crowded areas. Refrain from making sharp turns or abrupt stops. Operating the vehicle under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited. Regularly check that the vehicle is in good working order before each use.

Be aware of your environment and the current driving conditions. Avoid using the vehicle in extreme weather conditions, such as lightning storms or heavy rain. Exercise caution when driving on slopes or unfamiliar terrains. Before moving, make sure all passengers are seated and securely fastened.

Golf cart and LSV laws and regulations vary from state to state. Please ensure compliance with your local laws before operating.

Pre-Operations

Before operating your Denago® EV product, it's important to conduct a quick visual inspection. Confirm that the vehicle is in the “park position and the parking brake is engaged. Check tire pressure and fluid levels, and verify that there are no loose or broken parts.

To start your Denago® vehicle, insert the key into the ignition switch and turn it to the ‘ON’ position. On the dashboard, indicators display essential information, including battery status, headlight status, and turn signals.

Ensure that you and all passengers are securely seated with seatbelts fastened. When driving, always keep both hands on the steering wheel and adhere to all traffic regulations.

The brake pedal is positioned on the left, while the accelerator is on the right. To slow down or come to a stop, press the brake pedal. For increasing speed, gently press the accelerator.

Controls for the headlights, tail lights, and horn are conveniently located on the dashboard or steering column. Before each trip, make sure these components are fully functional.

Dashboard

Forward/Neutral/Reverse Switch

The Forward/Neutral/Reverse switch, located under the driver's seat, enables you to modify the direction of your vehicle's movement. It's crucial to make sure the vehicle is completely stationary before you switch between forward, neutral, and reverse modes.





Two Speed Modes

Your Denago® EV Nomad XL features two speed modes: L (15 mph) and H (25 mph). The mode switch is conveniently located on the dashboard.



Tilt Steering System

The Denago® EV Nomad XL's Tilt Steering System lets you easily adjust the steering wheel angle for comfort. Just unlock the tilt lever, set your angle, and lock it back in place.



Electro Magnetic Brake system

The Denago® EV Nomad XL's Electro Magnetic Brake system uses electromagnetism for efficient braking, reduces wear, and has a longer lifespan. No manual action is required to engage the brakes when parking.

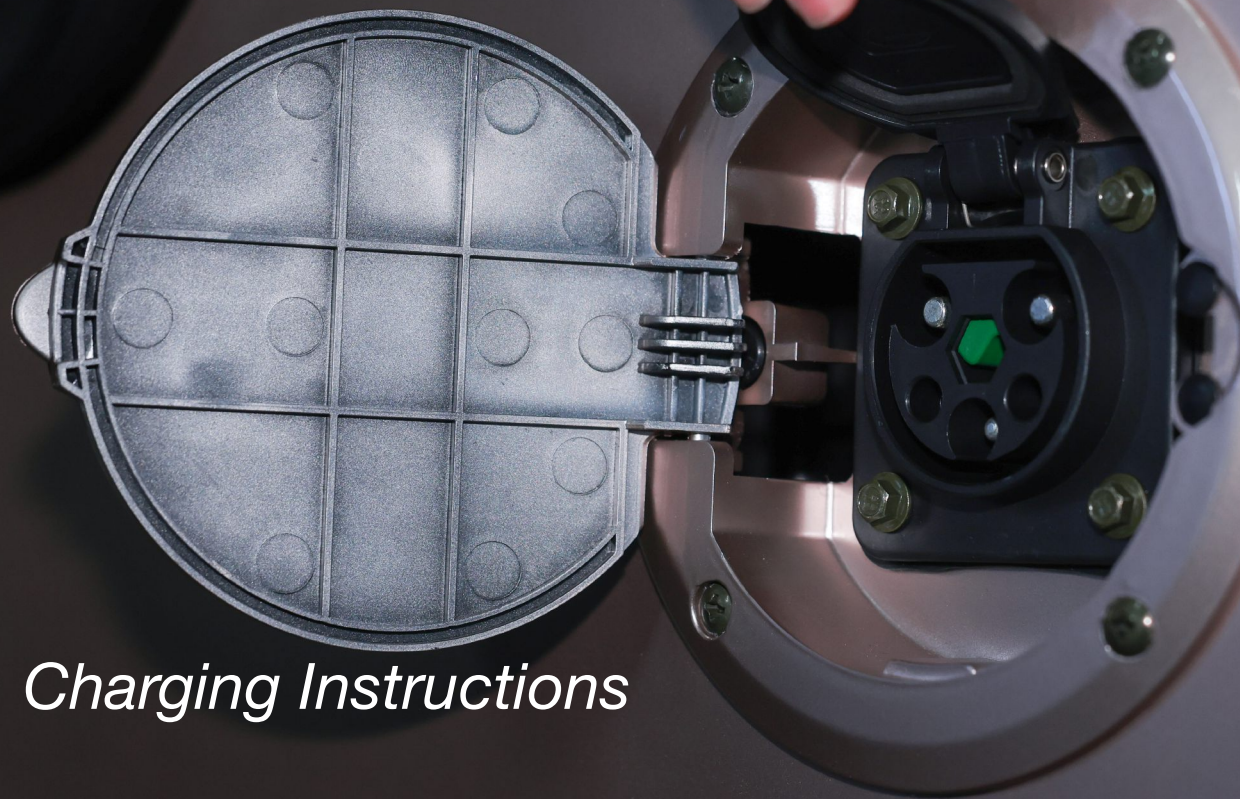
1. Charge the battery using only the approved charger provided by DENAGO.
